

26. Housekeeping

- A. Keep all aisles and passageways clear of all obstructions.
- B. Place refuse in the appropriate recycle, compost, or garbage containers. Place any items that could be reused in the appropriate location for that material.
- C. Clean up spilled liquids promptly. If the liquid is a hazardous chemical, then follow the procedures outlined in the "Hazardous Chemical Communication" section of the APP and notify a supervisor immediately.
- D. Use "Wet Floor" signs until slippery surfaces have been cleaned and are dry.
- E. You can pick your friends, you can pick your nose, but you can't pick your friend's nose. If you do...wash your hands!
- F. Store all tools and materials in their proper storage locations.
- G. Pesticides or other hazardous chemicals shall only be stored in designated areas.
- H. Keep restrooms, locker rooms and other facilities in a neat, clean and sanitary condition.
- I. Vehicles should be kept clean and free from objects on the floor which can interfere with braking and can become flying objects in the event of a sudden stop.
